

COURT DATA ACCESS INCLUDES ONLINE PAYMENTS

Macoupin County Circuit Clerk Mike Mathis announced that not only can individuals access Judici Court Records through the Macoupin County Government Website but they can also make online payments for Traffic & Criminal cases by using Mastercard, Discover or American Express. Credit Card payments can also be made when paying in person at the Courthouse. Visa is one of the few credit/debit cards that is NOT ALLOWED at this time.

This payment system is available to the Courts through a cooperative agreement with the State of Illinois Treasurer's Office.

Mathis stated that online payments along with other accessible information including, charges filed, case disposition, the ability to verify balances due, whether a payment has been received, and the date and time of future payments or hearings is helpful information that assists the Circuit Clerk's Office in better serving the public.

Andy Manar, Macoupin County Board Chairman, has long been a staunch advocate for getting as much information as possible on the internet. "The Macoupin County Government Website is constantly being updated with information and links that we hope will be beneficial to Macoupin County Residents." said Manar.

Circuit Clerk Mathis said "I am now working on the ability for individuals to print various Court forms from the County website saving trips to the Courthouse or waiting for the forms to be mailed to them."
