Instructions for Change of Name

- 1. Complete the Notice of Publication and Petition for Change of Name.
- 2. File your Petition for Change of Name in the Circuit Clerk's Office. Your Petition has to be notarized prior to filing. The Clerk requires a filing fee of \$210.00 in cash, money order, personal check (Macoupin County financial institutions only) or credit card.* The Circuit Clerk will give you a date to appear in court to hear your Petition. This date must be at least 6 weeks after the first publication appears in the newspaper.
- 3. Next you have to publish your Notice of Publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Macoupin County. You should take your Notice to the newspaper. The newspaper will charge you a fee to publish your Notice. The Notice must be published for 3 consecutive weeks after the Petition is filed, with the first insertion at least 6 weeks before your court hearing.
- 4. After publication is completed, the newspaper will mail you a Certificate of Publication. Make sure to take this Certificate with you to the Court hearing.
- After your court hearing, go to the Circuit Clerk's Office to obtain certified copies of your Order of Change of Name. There is no charge for the first certified copy and \$7.00 for each additional copy. The Clerk accepts payments in cash, money order, personal check (Macoupin County financial institutions only) or credit card.
- 6. If the Court grants your name change, you can change your birth certificate to your new name by: (a) If born in Illinois, mail a certified copy of the Order of Change of Name and a \$15.00 money order to: The Bureau of Vital Statistics, State of Illinois, Department of Health, Springfield, IL 62706. (b) If born outside of Illinois, contact the office which keeps the birth records for the state in which you were born for procedures and the appropriate fees.
- 7. If the Court grants your name change, you can change the name on your Social Security Card you must go to the nearest Social Security office and complete an application. You must bring a piece of identification, such as your old Social Security card, old birth certificate, and a certified copy of your Order of Change of Name with.
