Special Notes:

- A. All matters returnable on Court Holidays may be filed on the next business day of the Court.
- B. Pursuant to union contract negotiations, effective in 2022, Lincoln's Birthday is no longer observed. In lieu thereof, the entire days of Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve shall be observed.
